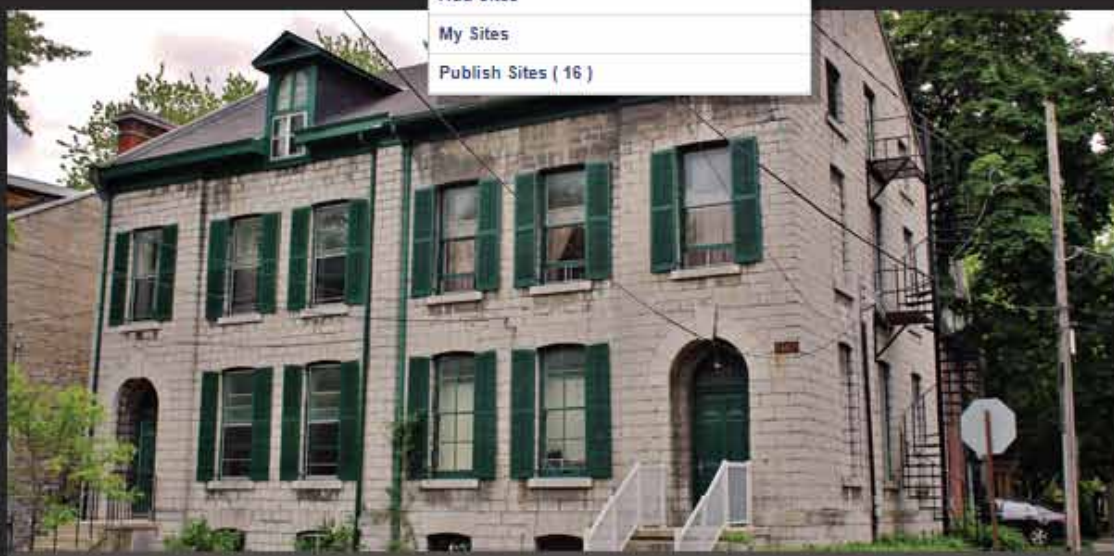

2. Continue onto **Caroline St N/Regional Road 9** 0.3 km
3. Turn **left** onto **Erb St W/Regional Road 9** (signs for **Erb Street**) 0.3 km
4. Turn **right** onto **King St S/Regional Road 15** 0.6 km
5. Turn **left** onto **Allen St E** 0.2 km
